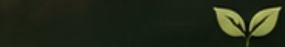

A thing can increase in size without increasing in strength, usefulness, fruitfulness, or maturity.



BIBLICALLY AND NATURALLY, GROWTH IS A **DESIGNED PROCESS**

by which hidden potential is progressively developed into stable, fruitful, self-reproducing capacity.

1 GROWTH BEGINS WITH SEED

Everything mature begins in an undeveloped form.

The seed contains potential, identity, instructions, and future fruit—but none of it is fully visible yet.

The beginning may appear small, unimpressive, and incomplete.

Yet the seed already contains the **design** of what it can **become**.

Every business begins with a seed:

The early question is not:



“How large is it?”

The better question is:



“What is contained within it?”



Do not judge **potential** solely by present appearance.

GROWTH REQUIRES THE RIGHT ENVIRONMENT

A good seed can fail in the wrong environment.
Growth depends upon conditions.

 **FOR A PLANT**, those conditions include:

Do not merely ask whether you have a good idea.

Potential needs an environment that agrees with its design.

GROWTH BEGINS BELOW THE SURFACE

Before a seed appears above ground,
important work is happening invisibly.



IT SOFTENS.

A plant cannot sustainably produce
above what its **roots can support**.

5 GROWTH OCCURS IN STAGES

Nothing moves from seed to maturity in one leap.
Growth unfolds progressively.

A TREE MOVES THROUGH STAGES SUCH AS:

-  **SEED**
Potential is contained within.
-  **SPROUT**
New life breaks through.
-  **SEEDLING**
Early growth takes root.
-  **SAPLING**
Strength and structure develop.
-  **MATURITY**
Established, stable, and strong.
-  **FRUITFULNESS**
Produces abundant fruit.
-  **REPRODUCTION**
Reproduces and starts again.

Each stage has different needs, vulnerabilities, and assignments.

GROWTH REQUIRES LIGHT

Plants grow toward **light**.

Light enables them to produce energy and reveals the direction of development.



In spiritual and practical terms, light represents **truth, understanding, clarity and revelation**.

Confusion **restricts growth**.

A business grows more effectively when it has **clarity** about:



Whom it serves



What problem it solves



What makes it different



How it creates value



What the next priority is



Activity without light creates wasted motion.



Growth accelerates when **truth clarifies direction**.

LIGHT BRINGS LIFE, CLARITY AND DIRECTION.

Follow the light, and growth follows.

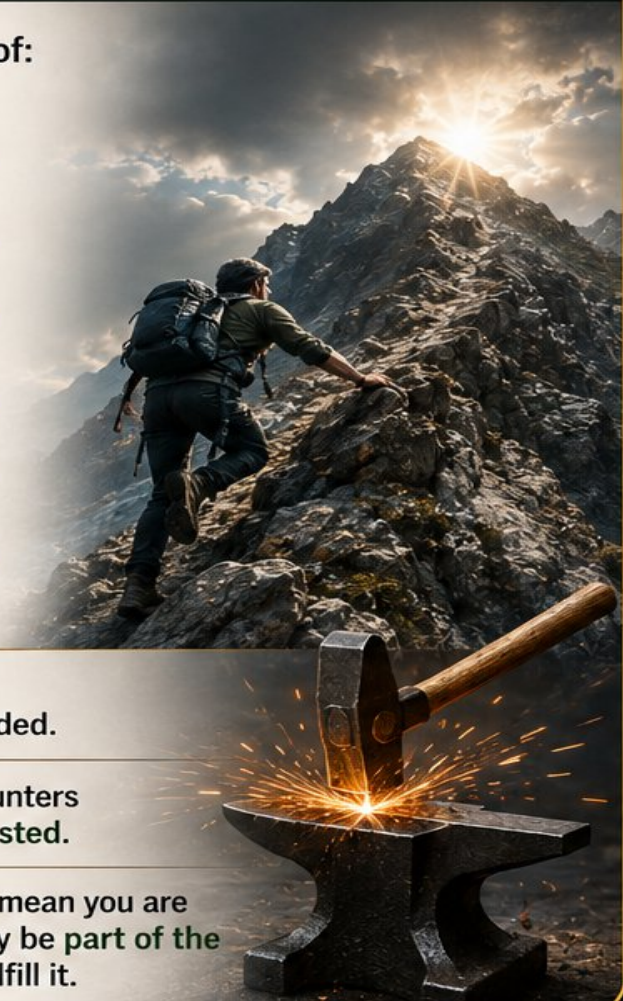

GROWTH REQUIRES PRUNING



Healthy growth includes **subtraction**. A tree may need dead, diseased, weak, or unproductive growth removed so that resources can be redirected.

Pruning can temporarily make something look smaller while making it **more fruitful**.

PRUNE TODAY. FLOURISH TOMORROW.

Remove what drains. Redirect what remains. Release what's best.

WHAT RESISTANCE IS REVEALING WEAKNESS?

What current problem is exposing a capacity that must be developed?

What is consuming resources without contributing to the mission?

What must become stronger before we can responsibly grow?
